

ADMISSION STEPS  
**RADIOGRAPHY**  
(2-YEAR ASSOCIATE DEGREE)

The applicant must complete and submit an "HCCS Application for Admission" on line at <http://saweb.hccs.cc.tx.us> if no previous enrollment or testing activity has taken place at HCCS.

### MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

- \_\_\_ 1. **Attend an on-campus Program Information Session.** Information Sessions are held the third Thursday of every month, 12 noon in room 473 A&B (excluding holidays and months when an evening session is held). Evening Information Sessions are held at 6:00 p.m. on these dates only: 10/10/2009, 03/08/2010, and 07/15/2009 in Room 581.
- \_\_\_ 2. **Submit the following to the Welcome Center/Room 111, located at 1900 Pressler St, Houston, TX, 77030.**
  - Paper Application for Health Sciences
  - Copy of high school transcript or GED Scores or copy of high school diploma, or college transcript showing admission as a high school graduate or that a degree was awarded. Must include name of high school with year of graduation on this document. Copy GPA at time of application must be 2.0 or above.
  - Proof of successful assessment testing placing you in college level course work
  - 'C' or better in the following prerequisite courses (ENGL 1301, MATH 1314, BIOL 2401, RADR 1201, HPRS 1106).
  - Recommended, but not required at time of application: transcript with completed academic core classes in Humanities/Fine Arts elective, SPCH 1311, PSYC 2301 or SOCI 1301.
  - Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.
- \_\_\_ 3. **Wait to be contacted by Radiography Department for a written interview. This will occur approximately 3-4 weeks after the application deadline. If you have not heard back from dept 4 wks after the deadline, you must contact the department in week 5 to keep your application open with the department. If successful in written interview you will be contacted for a 2<sup>nd</sup> interview.**
- \_\_\_ 4. **If accepted into the program, attend a MANDATORY program orientation/registration session. Absence from this session forfeits your opportunity to be admitted.**
- \_\_\_ 5. **If accepted, a condition of acceptance is the passing of a physical exam and a criminal background check and A 10 Panel Drug Screen at an agency approved by HCCS after acceptance but prior to the start of class. Student must also have a social security number, current immunizations, student health insurance, current Health Care Provider CPR, and be able to meet the essential functions of the profession.**
- \_\_\_ 6. **If accepted, hepatitis B vaccinations must be completed by the time of the New Student Orientation, which occurs about 1 ½ months before the semester begins. It takes 6 months to administer Hepatitis B vaccinations.**
- \_\_\_ 7. **Pay tuition prior to the start of classes.**

### INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- All International Students with F1 visa interested in Health Sciences Program MUST contact the International Student Operations Office at 3100 Main, Houston, Texas 77002, 11<sup>th</sup> floor, corner of Main and Elgin, 713-718-8520.
- Foreign transcripts (high school and college) must be evaluated by an approved evaluation institution (Ex. SpanTran, Global Credentials) and it must be a course-by-course evaluation.
- Students must have a social security number before applying to the program.

**Note:** For clinical education, students may be required to present documentation including, but, not limited to a social security card due to restrictions mandated by clinical affiliates.

### START OF CLASSES

- Classes begin in the summer semester. Didactic courses and most clinic courses are taught during the day. There is a possibility of limited evening clinical rotations in the second year of the Program. Program has one start date per year.

### APPLICATION DEADLINES

- **SUMMER:** on or before February 1<sup>st</sup> (**Note:** Application must be submitted by 5pm on the deadline date)
